14. Terms and conditions to be obeyed by the permit holder:

- Shooting of the film should be done on the place specified in the permit and should comply with the approved story.
- Do not shoot the film in the places other than the permitted areas.
- Film should not be produced against Nepal's national prestige, culture, tradition and religious values.
- Descriptions about the total production cost, artists involved and the places where the shooting was carried out should be submitted to the Ministry within 35 days of the production of the film.
- Foreign film producers should submit a copy of the film free of cost to the Ministry of Information and Communications before departure.
- Foreign film producer must take approval from the nearest Nepalese Embassy or Consulate General's Office or consulate office before the public show.
- At the time of advertising about the film for public exhibition, the technology mentioned in the permit and used in the filming should be mentioned in the advertisement materials.
- You should follow the directions regarding the film production given by the Ministry and Film Development Board.
- Follow the rules & regulations of Nepal
- Scoring the background music should be either Nepali Tune or of your own country
- Film should not be produced against real any citizen, country and community religion.
- Film producer should take care of good relationship between Nepal and other friendly countries.
- In case of aerial and/or shooting in restricted areas, you should follow the terms and conditions mentioned in approval letter of Ministry of Defence and Ministry of Home Affairs.
